

Camp information for all guests of the Bundeszentrum Wassergspreng (National Scout Center)

Arrival - Departure

When you arrive, please have your group representative get in touch at once with our customer liaison & support team on site who will provide you with all necessary information. The campsite, dormitories, sanitary facilities and seminar rooms must be returned in the same condition they have been taken over. The latest possible time for your departure is 4:00 pm unless you have made other arrangements with the BZW Team in advance.

TEAM PRESENCE ON SITE

During your stay, members of the BZW team may be conducting maintenance work on the site (e.g., mowing the lawn, making repairs, etc.). We will, of course, ensure that this does not disrupt your program.

Postcards

of the Bundeszentrum Wassergspreng are available in our shop. A letterbox can be found in Weissenbach, the next post office is situated in Hinterbrühl.

Medical Doctor and Pharmacy

You find the address and telephone number of the nearest doctor in information boards at the entrance of the "Mill", the passage to the "Saw", the shower container or in our welcome-folder.

What to do in and around the Scout Center?

The BZW Team will be glad to help you.

Information Boards

Can be found at the entrance of the "Mill", in the passage to the "Saw" and at the shower container

Cars and other vehicles

can be parked at the space in front of the Mill. It's forbidden to drive on the campsite. The access for ambulances, fire brigade and police must be kept entirely clear all the time.

Coaches

can turn around in front of the scout center, but please inform the BZW Team in advance, so that the space can be cleared beforehand. Parking for coaches is available nearby only if we have been given prior notice. Coaches for excursions can be booked on short notice.

Benches and Tables

are available for houseguests in an adequate number. Campsite guests can rent benches and tables. Indoor furniture must stay indoors!

Poles for building

are available for all guests. Please inform you customer liaison & support team before you fetch your poles. They will guide you to the right stacks. Poles should not be shortened; they are available in different lengths.

Any nails must be removed at the end of your camp; the poles must be returned without nails and/or strings to the place they have been taken from.

Trees and field damages

Trees must not be damaged or even cut down. The group representative will be liable to pay for all damages.



Batteries

must not be discarded with the residual waste. Please take empty batteries with you and dispose them professionally!

Bed-clothes

must be used even when using a sleeping back due to hygienic reasons. Covers for the pillow, the blanket and the mattress can be rented. The mattresses and pillows are covered with a protective covering – this is no substitute for the sheet or the blanket- or pillow-cover. Don't remove the protective covering on departure.

Biosphärenpark Wienerwald – Biosphere Reserve Wienerwald

The Bundeszentrum Wassergspreng is situated in the midst of the Biosphärenpark Wienerwald and borders on a core-zone in the east. The Biosphärenpark offers various possibilities for an adventurous camp program but also is strictly protected by law. In the core-zone ("the jungle of tomorrow") one must only use the marked paths – additional information and details can be obtained from the BZW Team!

Branding stamp

with the BZW-Logo can be obtained from the BZW Team.

Fire wood

can be found behind the open fire hall. It's not allowed to collect firewood in the woods. Please ask the BZW Team!

FOREST FIRE ORDINANCE of the Mödling District Authority

The Mödling District Authority enforces the Forest Fire Ordinance throughout the Mödling district. These ordinances must be observed. We have prepared a leaflet for the Wassergspreng Scout Center, which the person responsible for the guest group must receive upon arrival, read, and sign.

Bread

and freshly baked goods can be delivered but have to be ordered by the guests themselves. The BZW Team has all the necessary contact numbers.

Showers

in the Mill and the Saw are only available for houseguests. Campsite guests have designated showers in the area (Shower Container).

Groceries

There are supermarkets in the towns of Hinterbrühl (Spar, Billa ...) and Mödling.

Furniture

must stay indoors. It's not made for using outdoors. If benches and tables are needed on the campsite, please ask for them, the BZW Team is ready to assist.

First Aid Kits

Every group should bring one with them. If something is missing, please ask the BZW Team!

Fire extinguishers

can be found at all important positions in the houses.

Fire places

can be built on the campsite. Please use the prepared ones first, in exceptional cases a campfire can also be lighted on the campsite (only when using Fire Bowls or constructions above ground level) – please inform the BZW Team! In case of extreme dryness, a fire interdiction applies!



Access for fire brigades

must be possible all the time. The access routes must not be blocked.

Bottles (glass waste)

and other glass can be recycled in the designated recycling area.

Emergency exits

are signposted and must not be blocked!

Gaslamps

can be used following safety regulations.

Baggage transport

from the bus or train station can be organized according to your prior agreement with the BZW Team.

Dishwashing

Is not allowed in the washing facilities on the campsite (in front of the sanitary buildings) – risk of blockage! In front of the "Saw" you can use the "outdoor-sink".

Beverages

are sold in the "Saftladen" (Shop in the Mill).

Dogs

are not allowed on our campsite.

Slippers

are obligatory in the houses. Some can be borrowed.

Internet - WLAN

is available in and around the houses for events and seminars. The access code can be obtained from the BZW Team.

Chapel

is situated above the Saw.

Cooking equipment

can be lent (fee applies) to campsite guests.

Cooking places

can be built on the campsite. Poles for building, stones and bricks are available. Don't build cooking places in the ground. It's also possible to use the existing roofed cooking places as arranged with the BZW Team.

Camp constructions

can be done on the campsite. Enough poles are available. Before departing, the constructions must be unfastened; the building wood must go back to its designated place, free of nails and rope.

The group representative is responsible for all camp buildings!

Camp fire arena

is available. The official end of the campfire is at 10 pm, please be considerate of the neighbors.

Campsite and House Rules

In case of any violation of the campsite and house rules, the BZW Team claims the right to expel the group from the property without a refund of the camp fee.

Food remains

must not be disposed of in the creek or the toilets but in the designated bin for biological waste which can be found in the recycling area.



Recycling

is very important in the center. Please contact the BZW Team for more information, especially the different materials which must be recycled: Metal, Glass, Plastic, Paper, Biological Waste, Residual Waste, used Oil. Waste that was not separated according to these categories must be taken home by the groups.

Lights-out

from 10 pm to 6 am.

Smoking

is forbidden in the houses. There are smoking areas in front of both entrances – ash trays must be used, don't throw away cigarette butts!

Cleaning

of toilets, washing rooms etc. during the stay is part of the groups' responsibility. Do not wash dishes or shoes in the lavatories, there are designated places in front of the Saw ("Outdoor-Sink") and the Mill (shoe-washing area).

Cleaning material

for daily cleaning and for the final clean-up is provided by the BZW Team.

Sanitary facilities

Are available in the houses for indoor guests and at the campsite for outdoor guests. It is imperative to keep all facilities clean!

Shoe-Washing facility

is located next to the Mill at the parking area.

Sweets

can be bought in the shop "Saftladen"

Prevention of accidents

is of the utmost importance! The Bundeszentrum Wassergspreng doesn't assume liability for accidents of all kinds, the responsibility stays with our guests.

Tools

Please take with you whatever you need for your stay.

Caravan Campers

and mobile homes are not allowed at the center, there is no infrastructure for such vehicles. On rare occasions there might be an exception if requested in advance.

Vaccination against Ticks

is highly recommended.
