

# Information – Houses

### Arrival

Welcome! Are you responsible for the group? Please contact the BZW team before moving into the houses. Your supervisor will provide you with all the important information and explain the procedures. You'll find a written summary in the welcome folder.

### Departure

Please ensure that the dormitories, washrooms, toilets, kitchens, and seminar rooms are left clean before departure (according to the checklist). It is important that you strictly adhere to the agreed departure time! Please plan your stay so that you have left the premises by 4:00 PM (weekends) or 1:00 PM (summer)at the latest.

# TEAM presence on site

During your stay, members of the BZW team may be conducting maintenance work on the site (e.g., mowing the lawn, making repairs, etc.). We will, of course, ensure that this does not disrupt your program.

# Doctor and Pharmacy

Current addresses and information can be found on the noticeboards in the display cases at the mill entrance, in the passage to the sawmill, and at the shower container, as well as in the welcome folder.

#### Bedding

You must use it, primarily for hygiene reasons, even if you sleep in a sleeping bag. In exceptional cases, you can borrow a pillowcase, sheet, and duvet cover from us. The mattresses are covered with a mattress protector – this is not a replacement for the sheet. The same applies to the pillowcase. Please do not remove either!

# Furniture

remains indoors – it is not designed or intended for outdoor use. If tables/benches are needed at the campsite, please inquire with the BZW team.

#### O Dogs

Dogs are not allowed in the houses and the campsite for hygiene reasons!

# Slippers

Please wear slippers! A few pairs are available for borrowing.

# Internet – Wi-Fi

The Wi-Fi works well in the houses, but access is protected. Please ask the BZW team for the code!

## Waste separation

We separate metal, glass, plastic, paper, organic waste, residual waste and used oil. Please empty all trash cans into the designated bins in the waste area. Please take any unsorted waste home with you!

#### Quiet hours

are from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am. Please strictly observe the quiet hours; our neighbors will thank you!

#### Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in the buildings. Smoking areas are provided in front of both entrances. Please use the ashtrays and do not litter!

#### Cleaning

You are responsible for cleaning the toilets, washrooms, etc. during your stay. The sinks are not for washing shoes or dishes! There are designated areas for this at the sanitary containers or the shoe washing station close to the parking space.
