# Arrival

Welcome! Are you responsible for the group? Then please contact the BZW team before moving into the houses or campsite. Your supervisor will provide you with all the important information and explain the procedures. You'll find a written summary in the welcome folder.

# Departure

Please ensure that the campsites, dormitories, washrooms, restrooms, kitchens, and seminar rooms are left clean before departure (according to the checklist). It is important that you strictly adhere to the agreed departure time! Please plan your stay so that you have left the premises by 4:00 pm (weekends) or 1:00 pm (summer) at the latest. verlassen habt.

# TEAM presence on the campsite

During your stay, members of the BZW team may be conducting maintenance work on the grounds (e.g., mowing the lawn, making repairs, etc.). We will, of course, take care not to disrupt your program.

#### Doctors and pharmacies

Current addresses and information can be found on the noticeboards in the display cases at the mill entrance, in the passage to the sawmill, and at the shower container, as well as in the welcome folder.

#### Lumber

We are of course happy to provide you with lumber. Please inform the BZW team before taking it! Lumber comes in various lengths, so the poles must not be cut. If nails are used for construction, please ensure that all nails are removed upon return. Once the lumber has been removed, please stack it back in the designated lumber storage area.

# Trees – damage

We are located in a Biosphere Reserve. Therefore, we also protect our trees – they may not be damaged or felled under any circumstances. The group leader is liable for any damage to land.

#### Firewood

You'll find it behind the fire hall. You are not allowed to collect firewood in the forest. Please ask the BZW team!

# Cooking and fire pits or campfires

Please use the available cooking and fire pits if possible. In exceptional cases, you can also light a cooking or campfire on the campgrounds in consultation with the BZW team, but only in fire bowls or raised structures. Lumber, stones, and bricks are available.

Please observe the quiet hours at night when having a campfire; our neighbors will thank you. Please do not leave the fire unattended; extinguish it before you leave! Please dispose of the cold ashes in the designated container at the garbage island.

#### Washing dishes

Please do not wash dishes in the wash basins at the campsite (risk of clogging)! There is an outdoor washing basin in front of the "saw" that you can use.

#### Camp structures

You can build camp structures on the campgrounds – we'd love to see photos! There's plenty of lumber available. Please dismantle your structures before departure – this also applies to structures in the stream! Responsibility for camp structures lies with the respective group leader.

#### Quiet hours

are from 10 pm to 6 am.

# FOREST FIRE ORDINANCE of the Mödling District Authority

The Mödling District Authority enforces the Forest Fire Ordinance throughout the Mödling district. These ordinances must be observed. We have prepared a leaflet for the Wassergspreng Federal Center, which the person responsible for the guest group must receive upon arrival, read, and sign.

In case of violations of the camp site rules (camp site information), the BZW team reserves the right to expel participants from the site without refunding the camp fee!
